

A brief history of the College:

College of Educatio, Boko, a premiere teacher training institution in the south bank of Kamrup District of Assam, was established in the year 1998 with a view to scatter the rays of higher education and to meet the demand of the trained teachers in this educationally backward area. It was the result of some leading and thoughtful persons of the greater area who could realise the urgency and necessity of the Teacher Training College and so convened a general meeting on 31/5/1998 at Boko High school campus. In the meeting it was unanimously decided to start a B.Ed College and accordingly a strong Sponsoring Committee was constituted with Katiram Rabha, a freedom fighter and Ganeswar Saharia, a reputed teacher as President and Secretary respectively. Since then the College has not looked back. It started its classes at Boko High School own campus and later in the year 2000, it managed to shift in its present campus initially with 5 Bighas of land which now expanded to seven Bighas.

Location of the College:

The College is situated in the village Jarapara, 1.5 Km from Boko town in the district of Kamrup, Assam. According to GIS it is located at 91.2357 longitudinal and 25.97842 Latitudinal position. It is surrounded by eye-soothing landscape of nature. Beautiful paddy fields are in the East and North direction while the Boko Kanistha Mahavidyalaya and full view of NH 17 are in the west and south directions respectively.

As per direction of NCTE the College has already completed almost all the procedures of becoming a composite Institution of Teacher Education with D.El. Ed. course which has already got approval from the concerned authority.

College Emblem:

College of Education, Boko has its own emblem comprising the quotation Teacher is nation builder on which there is a blooming light symbolizing the eradication of illiteracy and spreading knowledg & light.

Infrastructure of the College:

The Infrastructure of College is as per NCTE norms. It has two Assam type buildings and a four storied R.C.C building where most of the requirements are available. It has well stocked library with specious reading room and a well equipped ICT Lab and a resourcefull Art & Drama Centre with proper facilities. There is a multipurpose Auditorium where most of the programmes like seminar, workshop, different meeting, yoga Classes and other community related programmes are held there.

Courses Offered:

- * Two year B.Ed. Course : Annual Intake 100 (As per NCTE Recognition)
- * Two Year D. El. Ed. Course: Annual Intake 100.

Medium of Instruction:

English and Assamese.

Internship/Teaching Practice:

* For 1st year B.Ed Class : One (1) Month.

* For 2nd Year B.Ed Class : Four (4) Months.

* For 2nd Sem D.El.Ed Class : One (1) Month.

* For 3rd Sem D.El.Ed Class : One (1) Month.

* For 4th Sem D.El.Ed Class : Four (4) Months.

Assignments:

Trainees have to prepare assignements compulsorily as per prescribed in the syllabus.

Schools allotted for Internship:

More than Ten (10) Secondary Schools from neighbouring areas for B.Ed. Course.

More than Fifteen (15) Govt. M.E., M.V. and L.P. Schools from neighbouring areas for D.El.Ed.

Course.

Admission Process:

Any graduate with minimum 50% marks, 45% marks incase of Sc, ST, OBC are eligible to apply for Entrance Examination conducted by Gauhati University. The candidate who qualified in the Entrance Examination can apply for admission in to the B.Ed course in the respective College and they are admitted according to the marks secured in the Entrance Exam. along with the rank. For D. El. Ed. course candidate have to obtained 50% marks in H.S. Examination (45% marks for ST/SC/OBC). Seats reservation for various categories as per Govt. norms. The admission process is based on the merit list prepared by SCERT, Assam.

Academic Session:

The College Academic Session usually begins in the month of September-October. A tentative programme of the activities of College during the session is outlined in the College Academic Calendar given at the end.

Attendance Rule:

Attendance in the classes is mandatory. A trainee must attend not less than 80% of the lectures deliverd in each subjects to be eligible for appearing in the B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. Examination. Submission of all assignments and practicum is mandatory in time.

Scholarship:

As per provision of Govt. the trainees belonging to SC, ST, OBC and Minority Catagories can apply for scholarship.

Fees Strueture:

Admission fee for the two year B. Ed & D.El.Ed courses for the session 2023-2025 is as follows-

1st Year B.Ed.	Rs. 65,000 (Sixty five thousands) only.
2 nd Year B.Ed.	Rs. 65,000 (Sixty five thousands) only.
1st Year D.El.Ed	Rs. 27,000 (Twenty seven thousands) only.
2 nd Year D.El.Ed	Rs. 27,000 (Twenty seven thousands) only.

The amount includes the Building & Establishment fees, Trainees Activities fees, Union fees, Tuition fees and Affiliation fees etc. This amount must be paid at the time of admission.

Trainees Association:

Trainees Association is formed within a month of their admission. They are divided into four different groups like A, B, C, D and one group leader and two Assistant Group Leaders are selected from each group. Other Portfolios have been divided as follows:

- 1. One co-ordinator.
- 2. Two Assistant Co-ordinators
- 3. One Secretary for Games and Sports.
- 4. Two Assistant Secretarys for Games and Sports.
- 5. One Secretary for Cultural Activities.
- 6. Two Assistant Secretarys for Cultural Activities.
- 7. One Secretary for Social Service.
- 9. One Secretary for Literary Activities.
- Two Assistant Secretarys for Literary Activities.

Co-Curricular Activities:

To promote a healthy corporate life among the students and afford to opportunities for their all-round development and also to become an efficient teacher in their future life various Co-Curricular Activities are organised throughout the year. Some of the most important activities are as follows -

Examinations:

Examinations for two years B. Ed. Course are held as follows-

Examination Tentative dates:

- * 1st Terminal Examination: 1st and 2nd Year, (Internal Examination) in the 1st Week of January.
 - * 2nd Terminal Examination: 1st and 2nd Year, (Internal Examination) 3rd Week of March)
- * Final Examination: 1st Year and 2nd Year, (External Examination) 3rd Week of July (As per GU notification).
- * A candidate in order to pass, must obtain at lest 40% Marks in aggregate and in individual paper also.
 - * Examinations for two years D.El.Ed. Course are as notified by SCERT, Assam time to time.

College Library:

The College of Education, Boko has a well stock library with books and journals more than the NCTE requirements. The reading room of the library is specious and it remain open during the working hours of the college. Each trainee is provided to non transferable library cards and is allowed to borrow the books against those cards at a time. The library is governed by the library rules. Borrowers must return the borrowed books within the fixed time. A borrower is personally responsible for loss or damage of any book borrowed.

Discipline:

* Identity Card : A non transferable identity card is issued to trainees after admissioin into the B. Ed. & D.El.Ed. Course. It is essential for any recognition or any claim by the trainee concerned and must be produced when demanded.
